The Oklahoma State Department of Health Community Development Service recognizes disparities that exist with vulnerable communities, especially during times of such as these. COVID-19 is a respiratory virus that affects everyone, but there are **reports emerging that the pandemic has a greater impact on minority (particularly African-American/black and Latino) communities across this country**. This may be due to greater rates of chronic conditions such as diabetes, lung disease, and heart disease among the minority populations.

The Community Development Service is working closely with partners and communities throughout the state to identify and provide resources on COVID-19 and information about the impact on local communities.
